Subject: - Administrative approval for implementation of Centrally Sponsored Scheme `Livestock Health and Disease Control (LH&DC)' under Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries, Government of India for the year 2015-16- amendment regarding

Sir,

This is in continuation to Department letters of even number dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2015 under which Administrative approval was issued for implementing Livestock Health and Disease Control (LH&DC) scheme with change in funding pattern during 2015-16 and letter dated 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2015 thereon.

- 2. As per Para 2 of Administrative Approval dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2015 it was conveyed that "Till such time, a decision on finalization of sharing pattern is taken by the Government, release of funds to States will be on the basis of 50:50 sharing pattern".
- 3. Now, under Rationalization of Centrally Sponsored Scheme on the basis of recommendations of the Sub-Group of Chief Ministers, as communicated by Ministry of Finance vide letter no 32/PSO/FS/2015 dated 28.10.2015 the funding pattern of Rashtriya Pashudhan Vikas Yojana (Livestock Mission, Veterinary Services and Dairy Development) has been revised to 60:40 between Centre and States except for North eastern States and Himalayan States in which the funding pattern will be 90:10 between Centre and States. Union Territories will be funded on 100% basis. The detail of component-wise funding pattern is as under:
