Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to convey the Administrative Approval for the Centrally Sponsored Scheme "Classical Swine Fever - Control Programme (CSF-CP)", and sanction of the President of India for the payment of Grants-in-Aid amounting to Rs. 32.00 Lakhs (Rupees Thirty-two Lakh only) to the Nagaland State Government under the Classical Swine Fever - Control Programme (CSF-CP), a component of Centrally Sponsored Scheme 'Livestock Health and Disease Control' release of central assistance for the current Financial Year (2017-18) with the condition that matching 10% share is provided by the State Government.

2. The Grants-in-Aid of Rs. 32.00 Lakhs (Rupees Thirty-two Lakh only) have been released in accordance with the approved pattern of financial assistance under the Scheme. The release to the Nagaland State Government is subject to the condition that the next instalment for release will be considered only after obtaining the information relating to fund-utilization and submission of Utilization Certificate by the Nagaland State Government.


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

The Grant-in-aid is sanctioned on the conditions that this will be utilized for the Scheme as specified in *para* 1 above and the estimate of the expenditure is treated as maximum and every effort is made to effect such economy as possible and also that expenditure is incurred in accordance with the ceiling approved by the Government of India under different Heads.
6. This Sanction is issued in exercise of delegated powers and with the concurrence of Finance Division of Ministry of Agriculture, Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries vide their Diary No. 2582/AS&FA dated 03.11.2017.
7. It is certified that the expenditure of Rs. 32.00 Lakhs (Rupees Thirty-two Lakh only) have been duly noted in the Register of Grants at Serial No. 03 Page No. 133 of 2017-18.
8. The audited figures of expenditure of the current financial year as well as previous years may please be furnished.
9. It is certified that no Utilization Certification is pending with the above-mentioned State as due for rendition under the Rules under the Scheme.
10. The Accounts regarding release of funds and their utilization shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and Internal Audit of the Principal Accounts Office of this Ministry.


