NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 25th July, 2011.

S.O. 1882(12).—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 3, and Section 3A of the Livestock Import (Prohibition) Act, 1968 (7 of 1968), and in exercise of the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Agriculture (Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fishing), published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part II, Section 1, Rule 12, dated 10th October, 2010, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such notification, the Central Government hereby prohibits, with effect from the date of publication of this notification, in the Official Gazette, namely:—

- (1) (i) the import into India from all countries, including Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (Highly Pathogenic Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza and Low Pathogenic Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza), of wild birds except those named and listed capacity;
- (ii) the import into India from the countries reporting Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (High Pathogenic Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza and Low Pathogenic Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza), the following live stock, and live stock products, namely:—
- (iii) domestic and wild birds (including poultry and captive birds);

- (ii) day-old chicks, ducklings and other newly hatched Avian species;
- (iii) unprocessed items and their products from Avian species, including domesticated, wild birds and poultry;
- (iv) hatching eggs;
- (v) eggs and unpasteurized liquid eggs (Pasteurized liquid eggs);
- (vi) unprocessed feathers;
- (vii) live pigs;
- (viii) pathological material and biological products from birds;
- (ix) products of animal origin (from birds) intended for use in animal feeding or for agricultural or medicinal use;
- (x) unprocessed deer meat and wild birds (including poultry).

Provided that the Central Government may allow the import of domesticated poultry from other countries predominantly or majority of the importing country.

- (2) The prohibition specified in paragraph (1) shall not be applicable to the import of:—
 - (i) processed yet heat and living products of meat and other products from birds intended for use in animal feeding;
 - (ii) the import of pathological materials and biological products for use in research purposes exclusively used by the National Veterinary Laboratories.
