- G.S.R..... In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Staff Car Driver Grade-I, Staff Car Driver Grade-II and Staff Car Driver (Ordinary Grade) in the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying namely:-
- 1. **Short title and commencement.** (1) These rules may be called the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Staff Car Driver Grade-I, Staff Car Driver Grade-II and Staff Car Driver (Ordinary Grade), Group 'C' Posts, Recruitment Rules, 2023.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. **Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix.** The number of posts, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. **Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.** The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
- 4. **Disqualification.** No person,
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal laws applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. **Power to relax.** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, itp may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 6. **Saving.** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-Servicemen, and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time, in this regard.

Deputation/re-employment for Ex-Servicemen:

Armed Forces Personnel due to retire or who are to be transferred to reserve within a period of one year and having requisite experience and qualifications prescribed under column (7) shall also be considered on deputation terms up to the date on which they are due for release from the armed forces and thereafter they may be continued on re-employment.

Note 1: The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/ Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years.

Note 2: The maximum age-limit for appointment by deputation/absorption shall be 'Not exceeding fifty six years' as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
