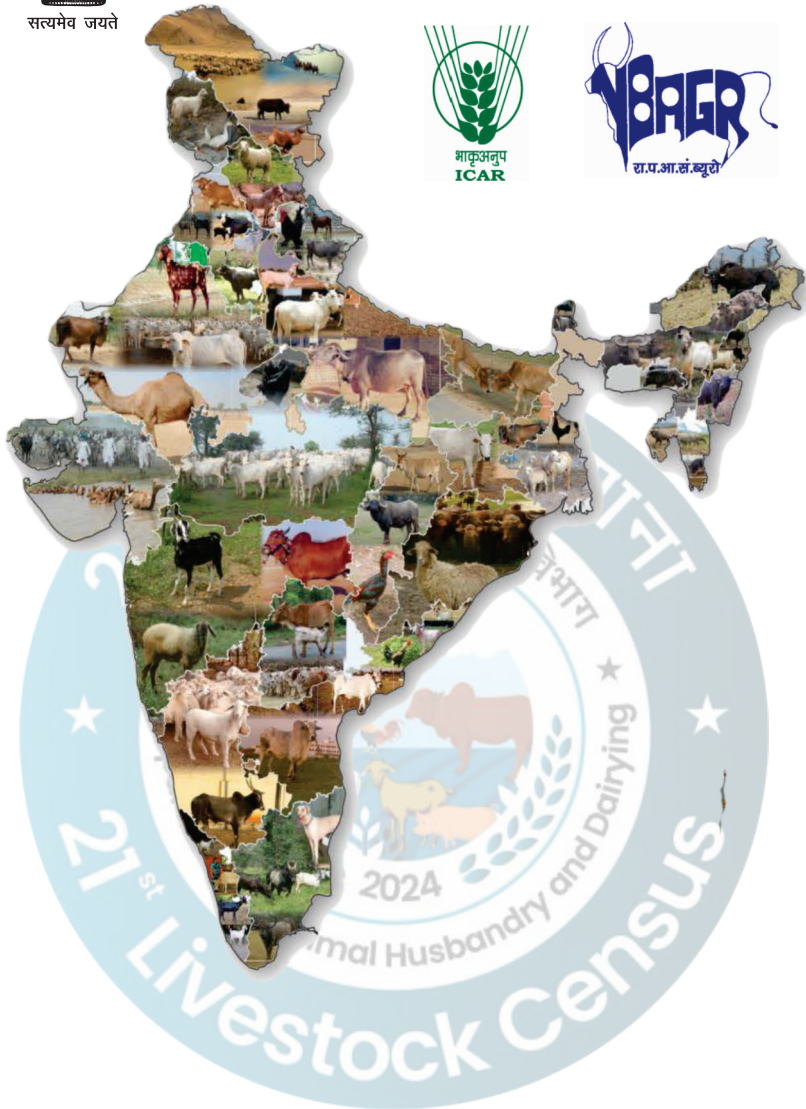

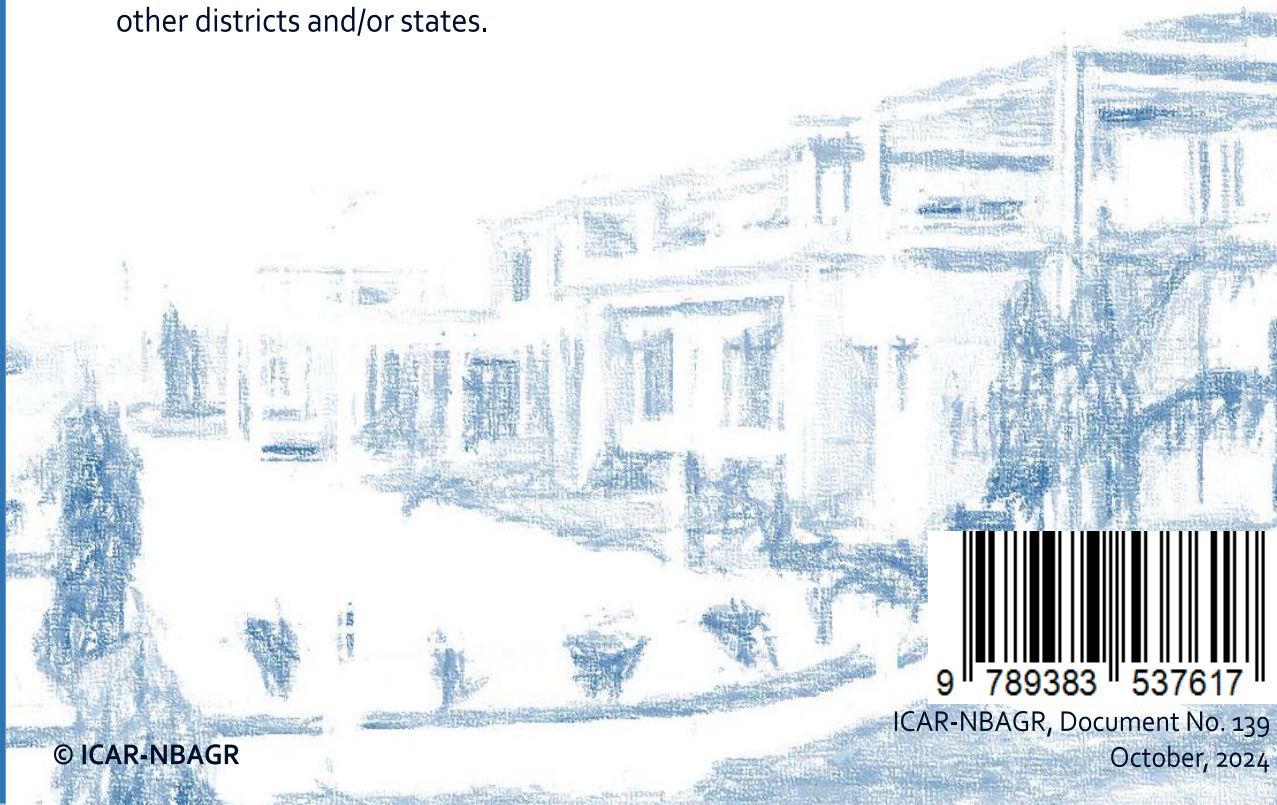

The Livestock Census in India has more than 100 years of history. The practice of Head-wise enumeration of all livestock and poultry being conducted every five years interval in our country is a unique framework in the world. The 19th Livestock Census (2013) had a special mark, as it initiated breed-wise animal data collection, for the first time in the country. All the breeds registered by the ICAR-National Bureau of Animal Genetic Resources were included in the nationwide survey. Further, in 2019, the Department of Animal Husbandry & Dairying (DAHD) conducted an actual Head-wise Breed Census on all registered breeds of various livestock and poultry species, pan India. This has led to monitoring of the breed diversity in the country. Based on the Breed-wise Census data, a Breed Watch List (2022) was prepared, which identified the Indigenous breeds 'at risk' and led to initiating conservation programs. Surely, the Livestock data has a wider use for the formulation of various policies and programs for the development of livestock in the country; the data are important for fulfilling the United Nation's Sustainable Developmental Goal 2 (Zero Hunger), specifically Indicator 2.5, related to Animal Genetic Diversity preservation in the country.

21st Livestock Census is the largest enumeration in terms of total livestock population and number of breeds in the country. In this Census, a total of 220 breeds registered by the Bureau along with other exotic breeds and their crosses are being included for head-wise enumeration, under various categories. Surely, determining the animal to a breed in the field by the enumerators is the most critical step as well as a challenging task for accurate enumeration. This 'Ready Reckoner on Animal Breeds in 21st Livestock Census (2024)' has been designed with this specific aim, so that the enumerators and officers may easily recognize and ascertain the breed based on the distinguishable characteristics. Along with breed photographs, we also depicted 4-5 distinguishable characteristics of the breed, along with its home tract in the state. The Reckoner has been made more illustrative for breed description and would be highly useful for all enumerators, supervisors, District Nodal Officers, and State Nodal Officers, involved in the 21st Census.
