(b) Being State subject, the Central Government has not assessed the infrastructure and facilities available in cow shelters in the country.

(c) The Veterinary Care and providing of health services is the mandate of the State Government. The Central Government is implementing the Livestock Health and Disease Control Programme (LH & DC) under which the State Governments

are assisted for disease control of animals in the States. These programmes are equally applicable for the animals in the cow shelters. Apart from the Government scheme implemented in the States, the cow shelters also have their own health care management system.
