4473. SHRI HANUMAN BENIWAL:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of farmers and milk producers from Rajasthan benefited under Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund (DIDF) and the basis on which they are benefited;
- (b) the number of villages covered under DIDF and the names of districts to which they belong;
- (c) whether any target has been set by the Government under DIDF; and
- (d) if so, the details of physical progress made in that direction, State-wise?

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER FOR FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING  
(SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)**

- (a) NDDDB has informed that Bhilwara Milk Union has availed financial assistance for “Establishment of new dairy plant of 500 TLPD at Bhilwara”. As on 28 February 2023, a total of 45.72 thousand farmers have been benefitted under the Scheme. With the creation of additional processing capacity, the project has facilitated the farmers’ access to the organised market.
- (b) The scheme is for creation of infrastructure for milk processing, drying, value added products, milk chilling and other dairy related infrastructure, which indirectly benefits the villages in the operational area of the dairy cooperatives. NDDDB has informed that as on 28 February 2023, a total of 27.51 thousand villages have been benefitted. The project-wise number of villages benefitted and the names of districts to which they belong is given at Annexure I.
- (c) The approved targets of the DIDF scheme are given as below:-
