- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to adopt villages to develop sustainable dairy farming in the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government proposed to provide funds in this regard and the targets fixed by the Government in this regard and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details and the number of villages identified for the purpose in the country and the time by which it is likely to be done, State-wise; and
- (d) whether funds are provided by the Union Government to the State Governments for implementation of the said schemes and if so, the details thereof during each of the last three years, State-wise?

ANSWER

**THE MINISTER FOR FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING
(SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)**

(a) to (d) There is no proposal to adopt villages to develop sustainable dairy farming in the country. However, in order to develop sustainable dairy farming Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying is implementing following schemes in all villages throughout the country: (i) RashtriyaGokul Mission; (ii) National Programme for Dairy Development; (iii) Dairy Infrastructure Development Fund; (iv) Support to State Dairy Cooperative Societies and Farmers Producers Organisations; (v) Dairy Entrepreneurship Development Scheme; (vi) Livestock Health and disease control Programme; (vii) Component of feed and fodder development under National Livestock Mission and (viii) Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund. Benefits of these schemes being implemented by the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying is accruing to more than 8 crore dairy farmers engaged in dairying in terms of enhancement in milk production and productivity, milk procurement, processing and marketing including modern technology. Government has also extended Kissan Credit Card (KCC) facility to Animal Husbandry farmers for their working capital requirements. Details of the funds released under during each of the last 3 years and current year State wise and year wise is at Annexure-I to V.
