### 3136. DR. PRITAM GOPINATHRAO MUNDE:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY & DAIRYING मत्स्यपालन, पशुपालन और डेयरी मंत्री be pleased to state:

- a. the total number of registered veterinary doctors in the country, State/UT-wise, as on June 01, 2023 particularly in Maharashtra;
- b. whether it is true that there is a 50 per cent shortage of veterinary doctors in Government hospitals for animals, if so, the details thereof;
- c. whether the Union Government has taken measures or issued policy directives to counter the problem; and
- d. if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

#### ANSWER

## THE MINISTER FOR FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY & DAIRYING (SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

- a. As compiled by the Veterinary Council of India (VCI), there are 81,938 Registered Veterinary Practitioners as on 31.03.2023. There are 10,570 registered veterinary practitioners in the State of Maharashtra. State wise details are placed as **Annexure-1**.
- b. Animal Husbandry is State subject and the staffing of government hospitals is done by the States depending on their requirement based on disease epidemiology and animal profile. As per the information received from the States there is varying percentage of shortage of veterinary doctors in some states, while others have no shortage.
- c. & d. The State Governments are competent to take measures and issue policy directives to provide for adequate veterinary doctors for their hospitals. The Veterinary Colleges opened/operated by the State Governments/ State Universities are recognized by the Union Government based on the recommendations and under the regulations of the Veterinary Council of India with the objective for maintaining quality of veterinary education. Private colleges are also regulated under the VCI regulations for quality of education.
