Subject: Regulation of import of livestock products under the Live-stock Importation Act, 1898: *post-import testing of raw hide / skin / furskins -regarding.*


Vide this Department's O.M. of even number dated 20th February, 2025 (**copy enclosed**), it was communicated that to limit any potential risk associated with import of raw hide, raw skin and raw furskins, the consignments pertaining to 20 tariff lines of raw hides and skins under chapter 41 (4101-4103) and 12 tariff lines of raw furskins under chapter 43 (4301-4302 except 43021940: tiger-cat skin) mapped with Animal Quarantine and Certification Service Station (AQCS) for import clearance, which are coming from the countries (country of origin and export) affected by Anthrax, Lumpy Skin Disease (LSD), African Swine Fever (ASF), Classical Swine Fever (CSF), Peste des petits ruminants (PPR), Sheep & Goat Pox and Foot & Mouth Disease (FMD) at the time of actual export, the mandatory compulsory testing will be carried out through designated laboratories depending upon source animal.

2. In continuation, the undersigned is directed to communicate that the requisite test may be undertaken at following Laboratories:

- (1) **Anthrax:** Regional Disease Diagnostic Laboratory (RDDDLs).
- (2) **FMD:** ICAR - National Institute on Foot & Mouth Disease (ICAR - NIFMD), Bhubaneswar.
- (3) **ASF, CSF:** ICAR- National Institute of High Security Animal Diseases (NIHSAD), Bhopal.
- (4) **LSD, PPR, Sheep and Goat Pox:** ICAR- National Institute of High Security Animal Diseases (NIHSAD), Bhopal, ICAR- National Institute of Veterinary Epidemiology and Disease Informatics (NIVEDI), Bengaluru and Southern Regional Disease Diagnostic Laboratory, Bengaluru.

Subject: Regulation of import of livestock products under the Live-stock Importation Act, 1898: *post-import testing of raw hide / skin / furskins* -regarding.


This Department is regulating import of livestock products under the Live-stock Importation Act, 1898. The procedure for import of livestock products into India has been notified vide S.O. 2666 (E), dated 16th October, 2014 and its further amendments.

2. To limit any potential risk associated with import of raw hide, raw skin and raw furskins, the consignments pertaining to 20 tariff lines of raw hides and skins under chapter 41 (4101-4103) and 12 tariff lines of raw furskins under chapter 43 (4301-4302 except 43021940: tiger-cat skin) mapped with Animal Quarantine and Certification Service Station (AQCS) for import clearance, which are coming from the country (country of origin and export) affected by Anthrax, Lumpy Skin Disease (LSD), African Swine Fever (ASF), Classical Swine Fever (CSF), Peste des petits ruminants (PPR), Sheep & Goat Pox and Foot & Mouth Disease (FMD), the mandatory compulsory testing will be carried out through designated laboratories depending upon source animal.
