- 4. Completion report of NPDD\_HR\_02D project needs to be submitted along with achievement against outcome targets particularly w.r.t. milk procurement & marketing, DCS coverage & addition of milk producers.
- 5. SLTMC (State Level Technical Management Committee) meeting to review project implementation has not been convened after Nov'2022.
- 6. No new project submitted since 2019-20 (QMP project was last project)

## Nation-wide KCC Campaign for Animal Husbandry and Dairy Farmers

#### **Provision of KCC to Animal Husbandry Farmers**

- RBI in February,2019 extended KCC facility to Animal Husbandry farmers and Fisheries for their working capital requirements.
- •Loan limit is arrived at based on Scale of Finance, which is fixed by State Level Technical Committee in consultation with District Level Technical Committee.
- •KCC card can be issued upto Rs 1.6 lakh without any collaterals and up to Rs 3 lakh without collateral if arrangements between producers & processors in place.
- •Benefits of Interest Subvention at 2% and Prompt Repayment Incentive at 3% to fisheries and animal husbandry farmers (upto a maximum limit of Rs. 2 lakhs) allowed through RBI circular in Aug 2019 for KCC.

## Budget Announcement 2025-26: Benefits for animal husbandry and dairy farmers under KCC

## The increased credit limit from Rs 3 lakh to Rs 5 lakh for KCC under MISS Scheme:

- will ensure higher limits for working capital requirements for animal husbandry and dairying.
- By increasing the IS limit to Rs.5.00 lakh without any sublimit, animal husbandry and dairy farmers will reap the benefit of subsidized working capital loan.
