



AGENDA -I: LIVESTOCK CENSUS



Status of 21st Livestock Census

- 21st Livestock Census has been Launched on 25th October, 2024 at New Delhi. All the States/UTs are supposed to complete census operation by the end of 31st March 2025.
- It is massive door to door exercise reaching about 6.6 lakh villages and about 1 lakh urban wards expecting enumeration of 29 crore households.
- Out of these, enumeration of about 27 crore households have completed so far.
- It includes completion of 3.92 crore villages and urban wards and in progress of 2.98 crore villages and wards.
- Captured enumeration of 37.88 crore livestock and 95.93 crore poultry birds so far as against 53.68 crore livestock and 85.18 crore poultry birds of 20th Livestock Census.



- Poultry realization is significantly high.


Chandigarh Progress (20th LC vs. 21st LC)



- ✤ Progress Enumeration completed (HH realization has reduced from 2,73,103 to 2,60,632).
- * Livestock Population in comparison to previous census is increased.
- ✤ Cattle and Buffalo Population has been decreased.
- Poultry count has reduced drastically (only 1910 as against 48,883 of last census)
- ♦ Goat rearing increased (increased from 998 nos. to 1410 nos.)

Jammu and Kashmir (%)














- Progress Not so good (work not started about 23% villages/wards, though 75% villages work in progress only 2% villages have been completed).








✤ Progress is not so encouraging (work not started in more than 17% villages).

Lakshadweep Progress



- Progress Field work Completed
- Livestock and poultry both are declining. (Livestock reduced from 45,697 to 21,047 and poultry is decreased from 2,26,025 to 84,559)
- *Cattle population declined from 2,493 to 216 and goat population is decreased from 43,188 to 20,806.*



Important Issues related to Census Exercise

- ✤ GPS coordinates information indicates that a very small percentage of data is being recorded actually from the field.
- Sharp decline in cattle and buffalo population to be supervised & scrutinized thoroughly.
- ✤ Calf recording is not found proportionate to the in milk animals.
- Significant number of rural villages shows no animals.
- Bulk request for reverting villages and urban wards due to various reasons indicates that data are not properly scrutinized at supervisor and DNO levels.
- ✤ States/UTs are to complete the census exercise latest by 31st March, 2025.

Issues related to ISS, if any

- Timely completion of ISS data collection is utmost required to analyse and release the season wise ISS data on time. National Accounts Division of MoSPI requires these data for their quarterly release of GVA data.
- In order to maintain data quality data collected at enumerator level necessarily be scrutinized at supervisory level.
- Pending units of survey 2024-25 may be completed on priority.
- Post allotted to the States/UTs to be filled urgently. Otherwise, these posts may be in question in next EFC which is due in FY 2025-26.
- First quarter of Survey 2025-26 has been started and need to be completed by 30th June, 2025
