Meghalaya

Issues

- 1. Overall achievement against targets particularly w.r.t. milk procurement & marketing is low (below baseline). Action plan for achieving the same may be informed.
- 2. Out of 3 New Milk Processing Plants (10 TLPD each), Ribhoi & Tura units were near to completion. **Present status may be informed.** Status of Electricity Connection and equipment installation work at Jowai Dairy Plant may be informed.
- 3. Since Milk Union has requested the State Government to provide 10% of the organization share part (about Rs.529.06 lakh), status of its receiving may be informed.
- 4. Next instalment of Rs.342.48 lakh under NPDD_ML_06I is under process. State/Milk Union to be ready with the pre-requisites (boarding on TSA, Mapping of Vendors, DSC etc.) and bills for immediate payment/utilization before 31.03.2025.

Pattern of financial assistance: Under the Component "B" of the scheme, an interest subvention of 2% per annum on the working capital loan is being provided to the producer owned Institutes (POIs.). Further, for prompt and timely repayment, an additional 2% per annum interest subvention is payable at the end of the loan repayment/interest servicing period.

Temporarily, the other component namely "working Capital loan" was kept in suspension since 2020-21.

Nation-wide KCC Campaign for Animal Husbandry and Dairy Farmers

• RBI in February,2019 extended KCC facility to Animal Husbandry farmers and Fisheries for their working capital requirements.

•Loan limit is arrived at based on Scale of Finance, which is fixed by State Level Technical Committee in consultation with District Level Technical Committee.

•KCC card can be issued upto Rs 1.6 lakh without any collaterals and up to Rs 3 lakh without collateral if arrangements between producers & processors in place.

•Benefits of Interest Subvention at 2% and Prompt Repayment Incentive at 3% to fisheries and animal husbandry farmers (upto a maximum limit of Rs. 2 lakhs) allowed through RBI circular in Aug 2019 for KCC.

Budget Announcement 2025-26: Benefits for animal husbandry and dairy farmers under KCC

The increased credit limit from Rs 3 lakh to Rs 5 lakh for KCC under MISS Scheme:

- will ensure higher limits for working capital requirements for animal husbandry and dairying.
- By increasing the IS limit to Rs.5.00 lakh without any sublimit , animal husbandry and dairy farmers will reap the benefit of subsidized working capital loan.
