7. It is certified that the expenditure of Rs.29,00,000.00 (Rupees Twenty nine lakh only) has been duly noted in the Expenditure control register at Serial No. 06 on Page No. 89 as stipulated in GFR rule 212(4)(b).

8. The Accounts regarding release of funds and their utilization shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and Internal Audit of the Principal Accounts Officer of this Ministry.

9. The further use of Grants in Aid being released by this sanction order, is to be done through (PFMS).
