MINUTES OF THE 21st NATIONAL STEERING COMMITTEE (NSC) MEETING HELD ON 19.09.2025

The 21st NSC meeting of RGM was held under the Chairpersonship of Secretary (AHD) on 19.09.2025 in KrishiBhawan New Delhi. The list of participants is at Annexure-I.

At the outset, the Chairman welcomed all the participants, and it was followed by agenda wise presentation by the Cattle Division to deliberate on the various project proposals for consideration by the National Steering Committee.

Agenda 1: Proposal for establishment of Heifer rearing centres (HRCs)

1.1 Department has received 7 proposals under the component of Establishment of Heifer rearing centres. The proposals were appraised by division as per the guidelines of the Scheme.

- (i) Sarhad Dairy – Kutch, Gujarat (Kutch)
- (ii) Kerala Livestock Development Board, (Thiruvananthapuram)
- (iii) Tripura Livestock Development agency, Tripura (West Tripura)
- (iv) Tamil Nadu Livestock Development Corporation- (Sivagangai& Salem)
- (v) Sabarkantha District Co-operative Milk Producers' union Ltd., Himatnagar, Gujarat (Sabarkantha)
- (vi) Panchmahal District Co-operative Milk Producers' union Ltd., Godhra, Gujarat (Panchmahal)

1.2 After a detailed discussion, it was decided to approve all 7 projects received under the component for establishment of HRCs, as per the details given in Annexure II. It was further stated that release of funds under this component (for setting up Heifer Rearing Centres) shall be made only upon receipt of the following from the Implementing Agencies (IAs):

- (i) A categorical commitment that NDDB / the concerned State Livestock Development Board will provide technical support in formulating norms and practices to ensure project viability;
- (ii) The commitment of the proposed IVF laboratory or IVF service provider to engage in IVF activities;
- (iii) Documentary evidence that the Implementing Agency has adequate financial resources to meet the remaining capital costs and working capital, aside from the government subsidy.

Agenda 2:Implementation of Nationwide Artificial insemination programme (2025-26)

2.1 The Division mentioned that during the previous NSC meeting, States were directed to upload pending data on PD (for AI performed up to February 2025) and calving (for calving up to November 2024). It was also mentioned that during the last NSC meeting, it had been decided that funds would be released to the States only after completion of uploading at least 70% of the pending PD and calving data.

It was submitted that the States have now uploaded the required data on the Bharat Pashudhan portal, and funds are urgently required by the States for continuation of activities under the component of the Nationwide Artificial Insemination Programme.

2.2 After detailed discussion, it was decided that funds under the component of the Nationwide Artificial Insemination Programme may be released in proportion to the entries of Artificial Insemination, PD, and calves born data uploaded on the Bharat Pashudhan portal.

The Meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
