Eligible Entities

Individuals, Self Help Groups (SHGs), Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs), Farmer Cooperative Organizations (FCOs), Joint Liability Groups (JLGs) and Section 8 Companies

Selection Criteria

Trained Entrepreneur or employing Trained Experts for running the project

Loan Sanctioned or Bank Guarantee in Self-financed projects

Own Land or Leased Land

Entrepreneurs for Breed Development in Rural Poultry

Activities Supported: For establishment of a Parent farm, Rural Hatchery, Brooder-cum-Mother Unit for hatching eggs and chicks, for rearing chicks upto four weeks in the Mother Unit (with minimum 1000 Parent layers) 1000 female and 100 male unit size.

Financial Assistance Available: Rs. 25 lakhs



Entrepreneurship Development of Indigenous Horse/Donkey and Camel

Activities Supported: For establishment of a Horse/ Donkey and Camel Breeding Unit.

Financial Assistance Available: Upto Rs. 50 Lakhs



Entrepreneurs for Breed Development in small ruminant sector (Sheep and Goat farming)

Activities Supported: For establishment of a Sheep and Goat Breeding Unit.

Financial Assistance Available: Upto Rs. 10 Lakhs to Rs. 50 Lakhs



Promotion of Piggery Entrepreneurs

Activities Supported: For setting up a Breeder Farm of unit size of 50 Sows and 05 Boars breeding animals sourced from Central or State Government/University farms or local farmers with high genetic merit.

Financial Assistance Available: Upto Rs. 15 Lakhs/Rs. 30 Lakhs

Entrepreneurship in Feed and Fodder

Activities Supported: For setting up a Fodder Value Addition Unit for Hay/Silage/ Total Mixed Ration (TMR) preparation, Fodder Block making or Storage facilities for Fodder.

Financial Assistance Available: Up to Rs. 50 lakhs

Establishment of Seed processing and grading infrastructure



Activities Supported: Establishment/ Modernization of seeds processing plant/storage for entrepreneurs.

Financial Assistance Available: Up to Rs. 50 lakhs

- Screening of application by State Implementing Agency (SIA) ➤ Approval of subsidy by DAHD
- Loan sanction by Lender ➤ Recommendation from State Level Executive Committee (SLEC)
