

Subject: Administrative approval for implementation of Revised Rashtriya Gokul Mission during 2026-27

As per approval of Cabinet vide No. CD No -067/ 2025 Dt.12.03.2025, DoE OM No. 42(02/PF-11/2014) Dt. 23.03.2026 & IFD OM No. G/11/2026-Budget(E;40715) Dt.30.3.2026 the undersigned is directed to convey the Administrative Approval for implementation of Revised Rashtriya Gokul Mission (RGM) throughout the country upto 30th September 2026 or date of the approval of the scheme for 16th FCC by the competent authority with an allocation of Rs. 800 crores.

2. The revised Rashtriya Gokul Mission will be implemented as part of umbrella scheme namely, Development Programmes as approved by the competent authority. The Mission has the following objectives: -

- i) Targeted raising productivity of indigenous bovine breeds through identification and propagation of elite animals of indigenous breeds under National Milk Recording Programme.
- ii) To create National Milch Herd of high genetic merit animals which consists of donors and propagation of elitist of elite animals through use modern reproductive bio techniques.
- iii) Mainstreaming use of modern breeding technologies such as sex sorted semen, IVF technology, genomics etc. for enhancing productivity of bovines at farmer's level.
- iv) To enhance Artificial insemination coverage through delivery of Artificial insemination services at farmers' doorstep

2. All the components of Scheme will be implemented on 100% grant-in-aid basis except the components of: i) promoting sex sorted semen under the component assistance upto 50% of the cost of sex sorted semen will be made available to participating farmers; ii) 3% interest subvention on loan taken by the farmer from milk unions/ financial institutions/ banks for induction of high genetic merit (HGM) IVF born Heifers and iii) One-time assistance of 35% of the capital cost for establishment of housing facility and induction of heifers in Heifer Rearing centers to implementing agencies.

3. It is requested that the Implementing Agencies (IA's) may formulate a single comprehensive proposal in order to avoid duplication/ overlap of activities as per guidelines of the scheme and submit proposal to DAHD. State Implementing Agency shall submit proposal to DAHD through State Government.

4. The State proposals will be scrutinized by the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying and sanctions will be issued with the approval of the competent authority.

5. The revised Rashtriya Gokul Mission (RGM) will be implemented as a Central Sector Scheme, with State Livestock Development Boards and the National Dairy Development Board designated as Central Nodal Agencies (CNAs), all of which have opened RBI e-Kuber accounts for fund flow. Where second-level State Government agencies such as Districts, Milk Federations/Unions, and ICAR Institutes are involved, they will function as Sub-Agencies (SAs) under the CNA; most have already opened RBI e-Kuber accounts and are mapped in

the TSA module of PFMS, while proposals for remaining accounts may be submitted by CNAs to DAHD. All CNA and Government SA accounts in RBI are "Assignment Accounts," with expenditure limits assigned periodically by the PAO through PFMS, and CNAs may further issue e-sub-assignments to SAs within these limits. The PAO shall debit the concerned Head of Account for appropriation but not transfer the cash directly to the CNA. It shall be retained in an interim account in respect of the CNA listed under the parent Ministry/ Department in the public account. Unutilized assignments will lapse to the Government at the close of the Financial Year as per the extant norms of Budget execution. UTs without legislature shall work directly on PFMS.

6. IA shall submit Utilization certificate (UC) as per format (12 A, Rule 238(1)) after end of each of every financial year through the State Government. IAs such as NDDDB, Central Universities, CCBFs, CFSP&TI and ICAR institutes shall submit UC directly. During the further release of funds balance amount of funds available in the account of IA will be considered.

7. Implementing Agency will supply information on number of people belonging to **Schedule Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Women** benefited from the scheme on quarterly basis. It may be ensured that 16.6% and 8.6% of the funds are targeted for SC and ST farmers/beneficiaries respectively under Scheduled Castes Special Plan (SCSP) and Tribal Sub Plan (TSP) as per directives of NITI Aayog.

8. Participating Implementing Agencies will submit monthly progress reports (MPR), annual report, audit reports etc. along with utilization certificate in the prescribed formats. The funds released under the project will be subjected to AG Audit of the concerned State.

10. Utilization of Grants in Aid being released under the scheme, is to be done through EAT module of PFMS. The Utilization Certificate not supported by the EAT module data is likely to be rejected and expenditure is not to be treated as regular. The agency would be forced to refund the amount released amount under the scheme as the expenditure not appearing in EAT module data. The IAs should reconcile the EAT reports with the submitted UC.
