If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder itself is MSE OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Turnover, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
2. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

4. Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid document (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.

5. **Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs):** Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Certificate and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service, and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted in case of product bids, whereas in case of services the eligibility is automatically validated. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

6. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

7. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -

1. Three similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 40% (forty percent) of the estimated cost; or

Description of Job: Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract (CAMC) 24X 7 of ETP with Operation, Preventive maintenance, repair/ replacement of components, chemical dosing to ensure treated water meets environmental standards laid by CPCB/ DPCC/ NGT or any other agencies including Effluent Quality Monitoring Systems of ETP Plant in DMS with real time online data transmission to CPCB/ DPCC server & monitoring etc. as per regulatory guidelines of CPCB/ DPCC/ NGT norms.

2. Scope of Work:- (a) DMS intends to invite offer/quotation for carrying out the Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract with operation Preventive maintenance, repair/ replacement of components, chemical dosing of Effluent Quality Monitoring System of ETP Plant in DMS for the measurement of the parameter i.e. flow, pH, TSS, COD, BOD & sending real time Data of all quality parameters to CPCB & DPCC servers & other specific parameter as per norms of CPCB/ DPCC/ NGT.

(b) The contract for outsourcing the above job shall be awarded initially for the period of two (02) years and the same can be extended further period of six months depending upon the satisfactory performance and at the sole discretion of General Manager or till the handing over the Operation & Management of DMS or closure of DMS activities due to any reasons, whichever is earlier.

(c) The party shall run the ETP on pre- installed and newly required instruments/ equipments. The various equipments have been supplied; Installed & Commissioned for online Effluent Quality Monitoring System of ETP Plant in DMS during September, 2015 and January 2026 by M/s Axis Nano Technologies Pvt. Limited, Mohali, Punjab. Details of equipments are mentioned as below:-

(d) The contractor has to provide the required parts free of cost for the existing all equipment of ETP during the Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract (C AMC) for operation of above online monitoring system. However if any additional features or equipment are required to be installed in ETP plant as per guidelines of DPCC/ CPCB, the cost of same shall be borne by DMS at actual.

(e) Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract with operation of Effluent quality monitoring system of ETP Plant in DMS as per CPCB & DPCC norms shall include all responsibility to comply with guidelines & rules provided by CPCB/DPCC/NGT. Party has to maintain the system comprehensively (including all parts) & shall run the system for a period of two (02) years. As the ETP Plant runs round the clock, for ensuring the correctness of the data being sent to CPCB & DPCC Server, whether the COD, BOD, TSS, pH and other parameters etc are in the prescribed range as mentioned by the CPCB & DPCC in the manual or amended time to time are properly maintained and recorded or not. Party shall be solely responsible for the correctness of data being sent to CPCB & DPCC server. Any consumables (and any other equipment or requirement is to be assessed & provided by the contractor & rates of consumables or any equipment shall be included in the rates offered.) No extra payment will be made to contractor for any consumables **or any equipment provided by the contractor.** Contractor has to maintain online testing record daily. This system should also have in place a corrective methodology in case any parameters go outside the prescribed limits of CPCB & DPCC. For any failure of equipments, data transmission, failure of surveillance system party will be liable to pay penalty levied by CPCB/ DPCC/NGT or any other agency.

(f) The party will be responsible of all the calibration, validation & running the system as per accuracy required for quality parameters (COD, BOD, pH, TSS, O

& G etc.). Resolution for Instrument should be up to minimum two decimal points. Accuracy of Instruments should be as per CPCB & DPCC or applicable standard. For any quality failure party will be responsible to pay penalty levied by CPCB & DPCC/NGT.

(g) Comprehensive Maintenance along with spare parts will be carried out by party for period of two (02) years apart from running the system for two (02) years at your cost. You have to maintain the system on daily basis in DMS for operation & maintenance/repair of Effluent quality monitoring system of ETP with existing equipments/ instruments or any other required equipments/ instruments by CPCB/ DPCC/NGT accordingly at your cost. The system shall also have a corrective methodology, in case any parameter goes beyond DPCC and CPCB specified limits. Whenever alert message received from DPCC like "Delhi Exceedance alert: Industry Name Delhi Milk Scheme which is near Shadipur Depot, West Patel Nagar, New Delhi-110008 has exceeded the value in ETP parameters, then preventative maintenance person should rectify this alert on priority. The contractor is responsible for any failure of equipments, data transmission, failure of surveillance system and failure in online monitoring system. Party is liable to pay penalty levied by DPCC/DPCC/DMS.

(h) Cleaning of bar screens/ sensors to be done regularly by the contractor.

(i) Contractor has to maintain the system in healthy condition as per his requirement.

3. **Good & Service Taxes:** The rates offered shall be included of Goods & Service Tax and all other levies inclusive all.

4. **EMD Deposit:** The bidders participating in the bid are required to deposit the EMD of Rs.25,000/- in the shape of Demand Draft/Pay Order/FDR in favour of General Manager, DMS along with their technical offer. Copy of EMD may be uploaded on GeM Portal along with technical offer at appropriate place. The original copy of EMD shall be required to be submitted well before closing date of tender.

5. **Exemption of EMD:** Bidders /Buyers are required to deposit the EMD along with tender offer. The offer / tender without EMD shall not be accepted. The bidder seeking EMD exemption, must submit the valid supporting document. Under MSE category as defined in MSE procurement policy issued by MSME, only manufacturers for goods and Service Providers for Services are eligible for exemption from EMD. Traders are excluded from the purview of this Policy. Therefore only manufacturers of Goods and service providers shall be considering for exemption under MSE category.

Further, Start-ups as recognized by Department of Promotion of Industry & Internal Trade (DPIIT) are also exempted from depositing EMD and experience certificate. Proof of registration as Micro and Small Enterprises and start-ups may be enclosed.

Further, MSE and start-ups are not exempted from experience and eligibility

ty criteria of the tender. All bidders including MSE & start-ups should have experience as per terms & conditions of the tender, however they are exempted from financial turnover.

6. **Eligibility Criteria and Documents required with Tender:** The tenderer/ bidder may submit the photocopy of following documents to ascertain the eligibility. Original may be produced for verification on demand:

(a) **Experience:**

(i) Bidder/Firm should have minimum 2 year experience for carrying out Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract (CAMC) / AMC with operation of Effluent Quality Monitoring Systems of ETP Plant or STP Plant with real time online data transmission monitoring etc. as per regulatory guidelines of CPCB/ DPCC norms. Copy of job order along with completion certificate executed by firm for above job may be enclosed with the technical bid of the tender.

The Bidder/Firm should have completed supply and installation/ erection of at least 03 Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP)/ Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) in any organization/ firm. Copy of job order along with completion certificate executed by firm for above job may be enclosed with the technical bid of the tender

(ii) Party has to submit a documentary proof that party has experience in CAMC/ AMC or supply and installation/ erection in such ETP/ STP plants who has been sending their online data to State Govt. Server/ Central Govt. Server i.e. CPCB/ DPCC

(b) **Declaration Certificate by bidders:** The Bidder/Firm shall required to provide a declaration certificate along with technical bid certifying that he is capable of delivering to the Scope of Work (SoW) and terms & conditions/ ATC of this tender (i.e. briefly operation and maintenance of ETP with real time online data transmission monitoring etc.) as per recent regulatory guidelines of CPCB/ DPCC.

(c) **Financial Turnover:** The bidders/ firm should have the average annual financial turnover of three years as specified in the GeM bid. However, MSE (as per GeM GTC) and Start-up are exempted from the financial turnover.

7. **Two Bid System:-** Above GeM tender is invited on two bid system basis i.e. technical bid and financial bid.

(a) Technical Bid:- Technical Bid consisting proof of experience, declaration certificate, financial turnover, Copy of PAN & Aadhar Card, GST certificate, EMD or EMD exemption certificate and other technical details as per terms and conditions of the tender may be uploaded along with technical bid on GeM Portal. It may be noted that Financial bid of only those responsive bidders shall be opened who qualifies the technical bid and who fulfil the eligibility criteria of the tender during evaluation of technical bid.

(b) Financial Bid/Price Bid:- Rate (inclusive of GST & all other charges) for Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract (CAMC) with Operation of Effluent

ent Quality Monitoring Systems of ETP Plant in DMS with real time online data transmission monitoring etc. as per recent regulatory guidelines of CPCB/DPCC norms is to be uploaded at appropriate place on GeM Portal. Further, the price breakup may also be uploaded in (.pdf) of Financial Bid on GeM Portal.

Note: It may be noted that tender of bidders will be rejected summarily if any bidder discloses their rate/price breakup in technical bid. Hence rate & price breakup may be uploaded with financial bid only.
