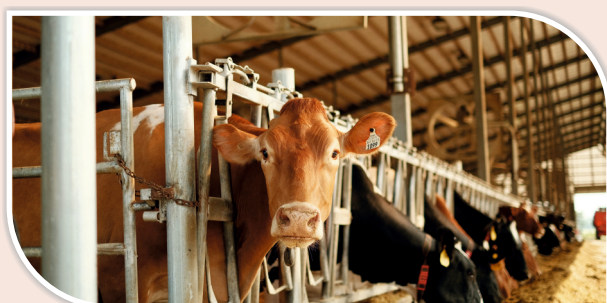

## Who are eligible

### Poultry and small Ruminant Farmers

Farmers, Poultry farmers, either individuals or joint borrowers, Joint Liability Groups or Self Help Groups including tenant farmers of sheep / goats / pigs / poultry birds / rabbits and having own, rented or leased sheds.



### Dairy Farmers

Farmers and Dairy farmers, either individuals or joint borrowers, Joint Liability Groups or Self Help Groups including tenant farmers having own, rented or leased sheds.

The working capital components for credit facilities in Animal Husbandry, may include recurring costs

towards feeding, veterinary aid, insurance of the milch animals, labour, water and electricity supply.

## How to Apply

Applicants can go to their nearest Bank, fill in the Application Form in physical mode and submit it to the Bank

AHDF KCC will be issued by Banks within 15 days of submission of complete Application Form.

Identity proof, latest photograph and filled in Application, as per Guidelines, need to be submitted to the Bank.

All processing fees waived off on AHDF KCC upto a limit of Rs. 3 lac.
