

Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month of November, 2021.

**1. Cattle & Dairy Development:**

- i. The Department organized a mega event to commemorate the birth centenary of Dr. Varghese Kurien (Milk Man of India), which was celebrated as National Milk Day, on November 26, 2021, jointly with National Dairy Development Board and other institutions created by Dr. Kurien, at the TK Patel Auditorium, National Dairy Development Board (NDDB) Campus, NDDB, Anand, Gujarat. Shri Hon'ble Union Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Parshottam Rupala inaugurated the IVF lab at Hessarghata, Karnataka and Dhamrod, Gujarat virtually and launched the Grand Start up Challenge 2.0 and web portal for breed multiplication farm. Hon'ble Union Minister, FAHD also felicitated the winners of Gopal Ratna Awards for the categories of the best dairy farmer, best artificial insemination technician and best dairy cooperative society (DCS).
- ii. The Department in association with Department of Financial Services launched a "Nationwide AHDF-KCC Campaign from 15<sup>th</sup> November 2021 to 15<sup>th</sup> February 2022, for providing Kisan Credit Card facility to all eligible Animal Husbandry and Dairy Farmers. Union Minister for Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying officially launched the Campaign on 15.11.2021 through virtual mode.

**2. Livestock Health:**

- i. On confirmation of re-incidence of Lumpy Skin Disease (LSD) in Gujarat and Delhi, these States were advised to take immediate bio-security and bio-safety measures including ring vaccination to control and contain the disease in a definite timeline.
- ii. On confirmation of incidence of Glanders in the state of Uttar Pradesh, Telangana and Madhya Pradesh, Department communicated the State to adopt zoo sanitary measures, monitor/restrict the equine movements to and from the infected area to prevent further spread of the disease.
- iii. The Department nominated Officers for the 44<sup>th</sup> Session of Codex Alimentarius Commission (CAC44) scheduled to be held virtually from 08<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> November and 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2021 including the report adoption on 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> November, 2021.

- iv. The Department in partnership with Confederation of Indian Industries (CII), celebrated International One Health Day on November 3, 2021 as part of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav on November 3, 2021, which marks the sixth annual International One Health Day by organizing a virtual Stakeholder Forum on "Industry & One Health".
- v. The Department nominated Officers for FAO-OIE-WHO Global Technical Meeting on MERS-CoV and Other Emerging Corona viruses held during 15-16 November 2021.
- vi. The Department agreed for the project on collaborative research on the project entitled "Generation of multivalent vector vaccine against Lumpy Skin Disease (LSD) in cattle and evaluation of its immunogenic potency" between North Eastern Regional Disease Diagnostic Laboratory (NERDDL), Guwahati and Department of Animal Biotechnology, Assam Agriculture University.

### 3. Credit, Extension and Publicity:

- i. As part of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, MoU was signed between DAHD and Ministry of Food Processing Industry on November 17, 2021 at Krishi Bhawan, New Delhi for Extension of benefits to Dairy Entrepreneurs/ Dairy industries through the convergence of various schemes of Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying in the presence of Hon'ble Union Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Shri Parshottam Rupala, Hon'ble Union Minister of Food Processing Industries, Shri Pashupati Kumar Paras, Hon'ble Minister of State for Food Processing Industries, Shri Prahlad Singh Patel and the Hon'ble Ministers of State of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying Dr. Sanjeev Kumar Balyan and Dr. L. Murugan.
- ii. The Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, with support from the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, organized a National stakeholder workshop on the National Action Plan to combat anti-microbial resistance (AMR) on November 23, 2021. The inauguration session of the workshop was addressed by Hon'ble Minister, Fisheries Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Shri Parshottam Rupala.

### 4. Trade/International Cooperation(IC):

- i. A meeting between Hon'ble FAHD Minister & H.E. Mr Andre Aranha Correa do Lago, the Ambassador of Brazil to India was held on 23.11.2021 to discuss Indo Brazil bilateral relations, Sanitary negotiation & cooperation in animal husbandry & dairy sector and the issue of export of bovine embryos from India to Brazil.

A meeting between JS(Trade) and Ms Amanda Kwek, First Secretary, Singapore High Commission, New Delhi was held on 09.11.2021 to discuss trade related issues between both the countries including the issue of proposed health certificate for export of heat treated poultry meat products from Singapore to India , proposed
