Summary of significant developments and major achievements of the Department during the month of July 2024.

1. Livestock Health:

I. Vaccination programme- salient achievements

a) FMD Vaccination

- (i) Round 4- so far, 14.32 crore FMD vaccination done and completed in 18 states and ongoing in 5 states.
- (ii) Round 5 of FMD vaccination started in Karnataka and Tamil Nadu and so far 1.78 crore vaccination done.
- (iii) Overall during the month of July, 2024, around 2.23 Crore FMD Vaccination has been done.

b) Brucellosis Vaccination

During the month, total of 26 lakh Brucellosis vaccinations have been done (Cumulative 3.87 crore)

c) Peste des Petits Ruminants (PPR) Vaccination

During the month, 0.66 Crore PPR vaccinations have been done. (Cumulative 14.65 crore)

d) CSF (Classical Swine Fever) Vaccination

During the month, total 3.44 lakh CSF vaccinations have been done. (Cumulative 54.82 lakh)

e) Other major achievement

In order to take up FMD free zones as per WOAAH guidelines, a meeting with the State viz. Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Punjab, Haryana and Uttarakhand for Diseases free zone for FMD was held on 25th July 2024.

II. Vaccination against Lumpy Skin Disease (LSD)

Overall 4.51 crore vaccinations done till July, 2024

III. MOBILE VETERINARY UNIT (MVU)

Overall, 3,182 MVUs are operational in 22 states providing last mile doorstep animal health care services. During the month, 2,363,75 no. of farmers were benefitted, and 4.38.478 number of animals were treated in 9 states.

IV. Activities/Works related to Veterinary Council of India (VCI):

- (a) The Gazette Notification of 11 elected members of VCI and Nominated members of VCI was published on 01.07.2024 and 09.07.2024 respectively.
- (b) President and Vice President of the Veterinary Council were elected on 26.07.2024.

V. Activities/Works related to Chaudhry Charan Singh National Institute of Animal Health (CSNIAH):

- (a) Completed quality control testing of 01 batch of FMD vaccines & 02 batches of PPR vaccines under LHDCP.
- (b) Team from Asian Development Bank (ADB) under Pandemic fund project on Animal Health Security Strengthening in India for Pandemic Response visited institute on 16.07.2024 for conducting the gap assessment activity of the Labs of CCSNIAH

2. Dairy Division:

- (I) The Guidelines for conferring “National Gopal Ratna Award-2024” in Animal Husbandry & Dairying has been issued on 01.07.2024.

Applications have been invited from individual(s) and organization(s) for these awards through National Award portal i.e. <https://awards.gov.in> starting from 15.07.2024. The closing date will be 31.08.2024.

(II) Special Inter-Ministerial Committee (IMC) meeting to review the prices of Agricultural Commodities chaired by Secretary, Department of Food and Public Distribution held on Thursday i.e. 11.07.2024 at 05.00 P.M in Room No. 41, Krishi Bhawan, New Delhi and the committee recommended that the following proposal may be placed before CoS and CoM

- i. Extension of Ban on Export of DoRB up to 31.01.2025 in order to maintain a stable input cost for Milk Producers.
- ii. The continuation of restriction on issuance of NOC for export of Wheat Bran up to 31.01.2025

The above recommendations of IMC, has been considered by CoS and CoM. Accordingly Department of Consumer Affairs (DoCA) has requested to DFGT, Department of Commerce and Industry for Notification of above proposals vide letter dated 31.07.2024.

- i. A meeting between Secretary, DAHD and H.E Mr. Juan Angulo Monsalve, Ambassador of Chile to India was held on 18.07.2024 to discuss India's and Chilean Trade interests. Both side also mutually agreed to activate the Joint Working Group under the MoU signed between India and Chile on cooperation in the field of Animal Health in 2003.
- ii. A meeting between Secretary, DAHD and H.E Mr. Patrick Rata, High Commissioner of New Zealand to India was held on 24.07.2024 to discuss bilateral cooperation including trade of animal origin products in the areas of Animal Health and Dairy. Both sides mutually agreed to expedite the MoU proposed to be signed between DAHD and New Zealand's Ministry of Primary Industry.

- i. 'A-HELP' Programme launched on 01.07.2024 at Jaipur, Rajasthan: A HELP program was launched in Rajasthan on 01.07.2024 at Rajasthan Livestock Management and Training Institute, Jaipur by Hon'ble minister Shri Zoraram Kumawat, Animal Husbandry Department, Government of Rajasthan.
- ii. Interactive session organized on World Zoonoses Day on 05.07.2024 at New Delhi to mark World Zoonoses Day, the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying was organized an interactive session chaired by the Secretary of Animal Husbandry and Dairying (AHD) on the eve of World Zoonoses Day.
- iii. Engaging session organized with A-Help on 20.07.2024 at Bhopal Engaging session was organized with A-HELP of Madhya Pradesh.
