NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the January 2024

G.S.R... - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the National Institute of Animal Health, Baghpat, Director (Group 'A' post) Recruitment Rules, 2007, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Director (Group 'A') in the National Institute of Animal Health, Baghpat in the Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement.** - (1) These rules may be called the National Institute of Animal Health, Baghpat, Director (Group 'A' post) Recruitment Rules, 2024.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Application.** - These rules shall apply to the post specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Number of post, classification and level in the pay matrix.** - The number of post, its classification and the level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

4. **Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.** - The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

5. **Disqualification.** - No person, -

- a. who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- b. who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Power to relax.** - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of these provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. **Savings.** - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes Ex-servicemen, and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
