1. Contribution of Livestock Sector in economy

As per the available estimates of National Account Statistics (NAS-2022), the Livestock Sector grew at a compound Annual Growth Rate of 7.67% during 2014-15 and 2021-22 at constant prices.

The share of livestock sector in GVA of Agriculture & Allied sector has increased to 30.47% in 2021-22 from 24.32% in 2014-15.

The share of livestock sector in total GVA has increased to 4.75% in 2021-22 from 4.02% in 2014-15.

The total output of the livestock sector is valued at Rs 8399 billion in 2021-22 at constant prices.

2. Estimates of Major Livestock Products (MLPs)

The data on estimates production of MLPs viz. milk, meat, egg and wool are the outcome of the scheme “Integrated Sample Survey” (ISS). It provides state wise and All-India figures on annual estimated production of MLPs.

▪ Highlights

- ❖ Total estimated milk production in the country for the year 2022-23 is 230.58 million tonnes with growth rate 3.83% over the previous year.
- ❖ The total egg production during the year 2022-23 is 138.38 billion numbers and it has increased by 6.77% over the previous year.
- ❖ Total estimated meat production in the country for the year 2022-23 is 9.77 million tonnes with growth rate 5.13 % over the previous year.
- ❖ The total wool production in the country in the year 2022-23 is 33.61 million kgs with growth rate 2.12% over the previous year.
- ❖ The State/UT wise MLP data for the year 2022-23 and 2021-22 along with annual growth rate are given in annexure (Table 1).
- ❖ The State/UT wise physical achievement of targeted annual production of MLPs for the year 2022-23 is placed at annexure (Table 2).

▪ Per Capita Availability of Milk, Egg, and Meat

- As per 2022-23 estimates of MLPs the Per Capita Availability of Milk, Egg and Meat is 459grams/day, 101 nos./Annum, and 7.10% Kg/Annum respectively.
- The State/UT wise data of Per Capita Availability of Milk, Egg and Meat for last three years are placed at the annexure (Table 3(a), Table 3(b)), and Table 3(c).

3. Livestock Census (LC)

Livestock are domesticated animals mainly contributing income to farmers. For arriving at the total livestock count, the species namely Cattle, Buffaloes, Sheep, Goat, Pigs, Horses & Ponies, Mules, Donkeys, Camels, Mithun and Yak were considered in 20th Livestock Census. The key results are summarised as below:

▪ Highlights

- ❖ The total Livestock population is 536.76 million in the country showing an increase of 4.8% over Livestock Census-2012. The total livestock population in rural and urban area is 514.11 million and 22.65 million respectively with percentage share of 95.78% for rural and 4.22% for urban area.
- ❖ The total livestock population in rural areas has increased by 4.56% and in urban area the increase is 11.19%.
- ❖ Total Bovine population (Cattle, Buffalo, Mithun and Yak) is 303.76 million in 2019 which shows an increase of 1.3% over the previous census.
- ❖ The total number of cattle in the country is 193.46 million in 2019 showing an increase of 1.3 % over previous Census.
- ❖ The Female Cattle (Cow population) is 145.91 million, increased by 18.6% over the previous census (2012).
- ❖ The Exotic/Crossbred and Indigenous/Non-descript Cattle population in the country is 51.36 million and 142.11 million respectively.
- ❖ The Indigenous/Non-descript female cattle population has increased by 10% in 2019 as compared to previous census.
- ❖ The population of the total Exotic/Crossbred Cattle has increased by 29.3% in 2019 as compared to previous census.
- ❖ There is a decline of 6% in the total Indigenous (both descript and non-descript) Cattle population over the previous census. However, the pace of decline of Indigenous Cattle population during 2012-2019 is much lesser as compared to 2007-12 which was about 9%.
- ❖ The total buffaloes in the country is 109.85 million showing an increase of about 1.1% over previous Census.
- ❖ The total milch animals (in-milk and dry) in cows and buffaloes is 125.75 million, an increase of 6.0 % over the previous census.
- ❖ The total sheep in the country is 74.26 million in 2019, increased by 14.1% over previous Census.
- ❖ The Goat population in the country in 2019 is 148.88 million showing an increase of 10.1% over the previous census.

- ❖ The total Pigs in the country is 9.06 million in the current Census, declined by 12.03% over the previous Census.
- ❖ The total Mithun in the country is 3.9 lakh in 2019, increased by 29.5% over previous Census.
- ❖ The total Yak in the country is Fifty-Eight Thousand in 2019, decreased by 24.9% over previous Census.
- ❖ The total Horses and Ponies in the country is 3.4 lakhs in 2019, decreased by 45.2% over previous Census.
- ❖ The total population of Mules in the country is Eighty-Four Thousand in 2019, decreased by 57.1% over previous Census.
- ❖ The total population of Donkeys in the country is 1.2 lakhs in 2019, decreased by 61.2% over previous Census.
- ❖ The total Camel population in the country is 2.5 lakhs in 2019, decreased by 37.1% over previous Census.
- ❖ The total Poultry in the country is 851.81 million in 2019, increased by 16.8% over previous Census.
- ❖ The total Backyard Poultry in the country is 317.07 million in 2019, increased by 45.8% over previous Census.
- ❖ The total Commercial Poultry in the country is 534.74 million in 2019, increased by 4.5% over previous Census.
- ❖ The number of households having cattle, buffalo, sheep, goat, pig and poultry are shown in Fig 1. The State/UT wise data are placed at annexure (Table No.5)

▪ Dairy Farm Households

Number of Farmers household having either cattle or buffaloes (Dairy Farms Household) is 80.83 million. The State/UT wise data are given in annexure (Table No.6).

▪ Landless Farmers

The total number of landless farmers having livestock at All-India level is 156012 (2.05% of Total Landless Households). The State/UT wise number of landless farmers having livestock is given in annexure (Table 7).

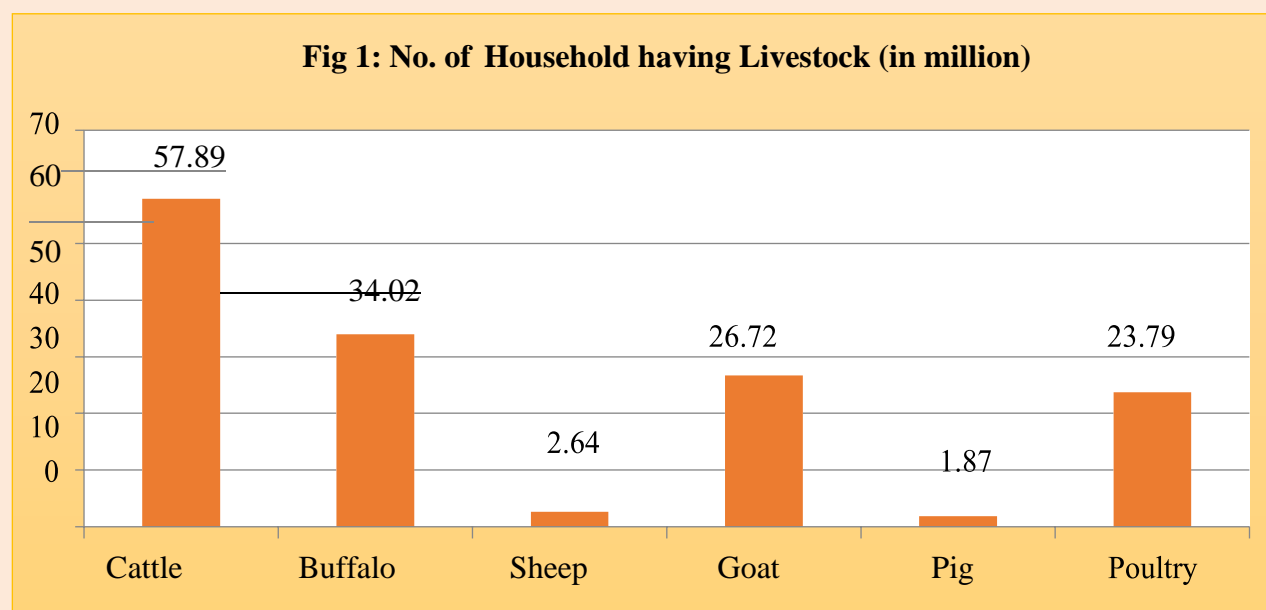
