OFFICE ORDER

Subject: Appointment of Nodal Officers from D/o Animal Husbandry and Dairying for monitoring/supervision of 21st Livestock Census - reg.

The Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairving (DAHD) launched the 21st Livestock Census operation on 25th October 2024, under the auspices of the Hon'ble Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying and this exercise is to be completed by February, 2025. Since the launch, data collection for the census has commenced across all States & Union Territories (UTs). To ensure timeline, quality data and effective support to the States & UTs, it is crucial to have proper monitoring of the census operation by the Central Team.

- 2. In this regard, it is decided to appoint Director/ Joint Commissioners/ Deputy Commissioners of DAHD as Nodal Officers for each State/UT. These Nodal Officers will oversee in-depth coordination, monitoring, and supervision of the census activities in their respective States/UTs and provide guidance to the States/UTs and feedback to AHS Division. A detailed list of Nodal Officers attached at Annexure.
- The Director of Animal Husbandry Department in each State/UT will act as the 3. State Coordination Officer (SCO) and will exchange daily updates on the progress & issues (if any) of data collection for the 21st Livestock Census to ensure accuracy and timely completion.
- Following are the broad guidelines to be performed by the Nodal Officers in association with SCOs:
 - i. Weekly Progress Report: To monitor weekly progress reports in terms of field work and issues if any.
 - Data Analysis: Monitor & analyse the data captured against each species/ breeds ii. at the district level in each State and compare it with the data from the previous census. Discrepancies, if any, are to be resolved in consultation with AHS Division.
- Communication of Issues: Address and communicate any issues faced by iii. States/UTs, such as problems with local government directories, software-related issues, or other concerns, to the AHS Division.

- 4. Census is a time bound activity and data collection is to be completed latest by February, 2025, the Nodal Officers are required to make visits to the States/UTs assigned to them to watch the ground position and to ensure smooth progress.
- 5. Progress/issues of Nodal Officers are to be reviewed in DAHD's senior officers meeting (SOM).
- 6. Department's Nodal Officers and State Coordination Officers are to comply with various directions of govt. issued in this regard from time to time.
- 7. Though there is no allocation of States/UTs, Joint Secretary and above level officers of DAHD may make their visit to any State/UT as per their convenience.
